

CIES Eurasia SIG Call for Papers

Situated within the overarching theme of the CIES conference “Revisioning Education for All,” the Eurasia SIG invites individual paper, poster, and panel proposals for the CIES 2014 conference which address issues of inequalities in education in the post-Soviet/socialist spaces of Eurasia and engage in reflections about the usefulness/feasibility of EFA as a global framework for measuring quality of education in the Eurasia region. We especially invite papers or panels that address the following questions:

1. What are the implications of the push for Education For All with respect to education quality for children and youth marginalized by socio-economic status, gender, ethnicity, race, sexuality, geographic location, and children and youth with disabilities?
2. How have the socio-economic transformations of the past twenty years and the Bologna process affected the quality of vocational and higher education?
3. On what dimensions do Newly Independent States (NIS) approximate as well as diverge in educational aims twenty years after the shift from the Soviet schooling model?
4. Which methodologies do researchers in Eurasia apply to identify and measure inequalities?
5. How do we reinvigorate the “education for all” concept inclusive of all populations and levels of education?
