Submission guidelines are as follows:

#### **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR INDIVIDUAL PRESENTATIONS**

Proposals for an individual presentation should be 500-750 words in length and should include the following information even if the results, findings and/or conclusions are still preliminary at the time of the submission:

1. Objectives or purposes of the presentation.
2. Main perspective or theoretical/conceptual framework utilized.
3. Analytical methods, research design, or modes of inquiry.
4. Results and/or conclusions.
5. Significance of the study to the field

Individuals may submit ONE proposal to the SIG sessions:
